

Eminent Microbiologist Announces Formal Clinical Trials of Silver Thread

*Fabric to confirm MRSA-
busting properties of new
fabric in patient care*

Dr Peter Wilson, a respected London Consultant Microbiologist has announced that he is to run formal trials in Newham University Hospital in East London to establish the effectiveness of Toray Textiles' See it Safe silver thread fabric in eliminating MRSA and other bacteria.

Interviewed recently on BBC Radio Nottingham, Dr Wilson stated that over a period of 12 months around 300 patients who have contracted MRSA will be monitored.
